## **A P-DEF PROJECT**

**Refugee Adolescent Women  
February 15 2017 to November 30 2017**

We aim to bring voice to refugee adolescent women from the Democratic Republic of Congo, living in refugee camps in rural Burundi and within the community in the capital city Bujumbura. Using a qualitative concept mapping technique, we will work with these refugee women to hear their challenges and successes in fostering their maternal health within their camp or community settings. Migrating from one resource poor setting to another, these women face untold challenges in accessing maternal health care, but also pockets of success as international aid agencies provide some support.
